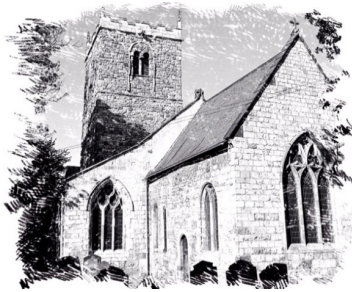


The Yorkshire Medieval Festival

St Mary's Bishophill Junior, York YO1 6EN (off Priory St)

From **11am to 4.30pm**: St Mary's will be open for visitors to tour its fascinating medieval interior and see a display of material related to the history of Bishophill supplied by **The York Archaeological Trust** and **The Bishophill History Group**.

12.00pm: There will be a group **tour of Bishophill** (from the church door) during which a member of the Bishophill History Group will point out and outline the historic importance of the parish's most significant buildings or places of interest.

3.30pm: **The Rudgate Singers** will be singing First Vespers of Sunday. This is followed by the singing of the Solemn York Salve Regina. This is a genuine piece of York chant (from St Mary's Abbey) performed in its own city.

8.00pm: **The Rudgate Singers** will sing Compline according to the Dominican Rite.
